# TALK DESCRIPTIONS

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## HUMAN DIGNITY

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This presentation is crafted to engage students' minds and hearts toward the inherent dignity of the human person.

Through storytelling, real-life examples, natural law, and scientific evidence, we pose the question: What is it about human beings that sets them apart? **We discuss the splendor of the human person and define human dignity as the unique value inherent to each of us.** We celebrate the magnificence of human life with stunning images, state-of-the-art footage, and fascinating facts. We address modern-day violations of human dignity and ask the question: How do we reverse this? We empower students to understand that personal virtue has the power to humanize. ## SEXUAL INTEGRITY

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Why do happiness and love so often seem unattainable? Why do the self-serving promises of today leave our lives colorless, ugly, and unfulfilled?

Through the use of stories, cultural examples, and personal witness, we invite students to consider their own use of media and how we can all utilize the incredible tools that our modern day offers to become a force for good in our communities and become people who leave a lasting positive impact on our world.
